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## CHAPTER MMCXXI.

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AN ACT TO REVIVE AND AMEND AN ACT, ENTITLED, "AN ACT TO ENABLE THE GOVERNOR OF THIS COMMONWEALTH TO INCORPORATE A COMPANY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING THE CULTIVATION OF VINES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES THEREIN MENTIONED."<sup>1</sup>

Whereas it hath been represented to the legislature of this commonwealth, that a sufficient number of shares of the stock of the intended company for promoting the cultivation of vines, to entitle the subscribers to a charter of incorporation, has not yet been subscribed, and that they have not been able to proceed to the planting and cultivation thereof, by reason of which they have ceased to be entitled to the rights and privileges originally intended to be granted to them. Therefore:

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the act, entitled, "An act to enable the governor of this commonwealth to incorporate a company, for the purpose of promoting the cultivation of vines, and for other purposes therein mentioned," be, and the same hereby is, revived, except so much thereof as is hereinafter altered or amended.

[Section II.] (Section II, P. L.) And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That Samuel Miles, Timothy Pickering, Israel Whelen, Benjamin Smith Barton, Benjamin Say, William Sheaff, Peter Stephen Duponceau, John Vaughan, B. H. Latrobe, Simon Chaudron, Samuel Coates, Stephen Gerard, James Gibson, Samuel Wetherill and Casper Wistar, junior, be, and they are hereby, appointed commissioners, to procure, in such manner as they shall deem most expedient, such a further number of subscriptions to the said company, as will, with the shares already subscribed, complete the amount of one thousand; and the said commissioners, or any five of them, shall have power to do and execute all and singular the duties, and exercise all the powers given by the said before recited act, and shall further have power to associate to themselves such other persons, not residing in or near the city of Philadelphia, as they shall think fit; and the said commissioners, or any of them, shall have power to receive subscriptions, in such manner as may be prescribed by a majority of those hereinabove named, anything in the before recited act to the contrary in anywise notwithstanding.

[Section III.] (Section III, P. L.) And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That if the said company shall not, within five years after the date of their charter of incorporation, proceed in planting and cultivating vines, agreeably to the true intent and meaning of this act, and of the said recited act, then it shall be lawful for the legislature of this commonwealth to assume all and singular the rights, liberties, privileges and franchises granted to the said company, otherwise the same shall remain in full force and virtue, during and until the full end and term of twenty years from the date at which the charter of incorporation shall, in pursuance of this act, be given.
