the authority of the same, That, in addition to the commissioners appointed by the act, entitled, "An act for raising, by way of lottery, a sum not exceeding ten thousand dollars, for the purpose of completing the building of the roman catholic church of Saint Augustin, in the city of Philadelphia," passed the fourth day of April, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine,<sup>1</sup> Edward Carrell, John Taggard and Thomas Shortall, be, and they are hereby, appointed commissioners, who, in common with the commissioners already apointed shall take the same [qualification, have the same powers], and be subject to the same duties, as are prescribed by the before recited act; and the presence of any two of the six commissioners shall be necessary to every day's drawing of the said lottery.

## CHAPTER MMCXXXVI.

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE ACT, ENTITLED, "A SUPPLEMENT TO AN ACT FOR ESTABLISHING AN EXPLICIT FEE BILL."1

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the supplement to the act, entitled, "An act for establishing an explicit fee bill,"<sup>2</sup> passed on the sixteenth of March, one thousand seven hundred and ninetyeight, and all things therein contained, be, and the same is hereby, extended and rendered perpetual.
