pursuance of the powers given to the courts of judicature, by the act, entitled "An act to enable executors and administrators, by leave of court, to convey lands and tenements contracted for with their decedents, and for other purposes therein mentioned," passed the thirty-first day of March, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-two: (1) Provided always, that nothing herein contained, shall be deemed or construed to bar or defeat any other person or persons, bodies politic or corporate, of any right, title, interest, claim or demand, which they may have, in, or to the said lot or piece of land, or any part thereof.

CHAPTER MMCCXXXVIII.

AN ACT ALTERING THE PLACE OF HOLDING THE ELECTIONS IN AIR TOWNSHIP, IN THE COUNTY OF BEDFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the electors residing within the fifth district, in the county of Bedford, shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by Jacob Four, in M'Connelsburg; any former law to the contrary thereof notwithstanding.
