## CHAPTER MMCCCLXXXIV.

A SUPPLEMENT TO THE ACT, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO COMPLETE THE BENEVOLENT INTENTION OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THIS COMMON-WEALTH, BY DISTRIBUTING THE DONATION LANDS TO ALL WHO ARE ENTITLED THERETO." (1)

Section I. (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the sixth section of the act entitled "An act to complete the benevolent intention of the legislature of this commonwealth, by distributing the donation lands to all who are entitled thereto," passed the second day of April, one thousand eight hundred and two, (1) be and the same hereby is extended and continued in full force for and during the term of one year, and no longer.

## CHAPTER MMCCCLXXXV.

AN ACT SECURING TO MECHANICS AND OTHERS PAYMENT FOR THEIR LABOR AND MATERIALS IN ERECTING ANY HOUSE OR OTHER BUILDING WITHIN THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA, THE DISTRICT OF SOUTHWARK AND THE TOWNSHIP OF THE NORTHERN LIBERTIES.

Section I. (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That all and every dwelling-house or other building hereafter constructed and erected, within the city of Philadelphia, the district of Southwark and the township of the Northern Liberties, shall be subject to the payment of the debts contracted by the owner or owners thereof, for or by reason of any work done, or materials found
